Over the past few years we have been unable to visit people who have experienced bereavement and have been restricted to sending out sympathy and anniversary cards to those who have lost loved ones. We have also organised the November masses for the families of people who have died during the preceding year and hope to be able to resume our home visits when we are informed by the diocesan authorities that it is OK to do so. Parish Uganda Link N1107201: The Parish Uganda Link group held meetings during Covid, via zoom, and now continues to meet on a monthly basis. We are building on our partnership with St Kizito's Parish through providing support to schools and the local community. Our work now involves 3 main areas of activity.

The Pupil Sponsorship Scheme - funding support from our parishioners provides access to education for primary age children from families who cannot afford to pay the required school fees.

The Food Poverty Programme - this started during lockdown and with the help of Kilmore and Killyleagh parishioners we provide funding to alleviate hunger in the poorest of families in St Kizito's Parish.

Parish Clinic - supporting with financial help to complete the final work at the clinic. This much needed facility will provide access to basic health care at local level including services for eye treatment, malaria and general health checks.

If you contribute through your envelope by bank standing order or cheque and pay income tax, we would ask that you sign and return the Gift Aid card at the front of your box of envelopes (put in collection basket with your next envelope) which will enable the Parish to claim back the tax you have already paid to the Inland Revenue on the amount of your contribution — an extra 25p or so in every £1 contributed.

In recent years we have received back an average of £16,000 each year from the Inland Revenue.
