Parish Uganda Link – Update and Thanks:

As parishioners have been aware, we are now in the third year of the Education Support Initiative.

Term 2 of 3 has commenced in Ugandan schools at the beginning of May and we have been able to transfer money covering the school fees of 143 children (the number of sponsored children has increased over the last few weeks thanks to expressions of interest from a few new sponsors).

On behalf of all the children in St Dominic's and St Kizito's Primary Schools in Kibiri, Uganda, their families, the Principals and teachers, and Kibiri Parish Pastoral Council, we would like to THANK all those who have been supporting this scheme over the last 2 years and those who have recently joined following our repeated appeal.

Your contribution means not only access to education for the poorest children in Kibiri parish and community but also their improved well-being.

Some of you have received a letter from us recently with a short profile of the pupil(s) you have undertaken to support. Those whose pupil assignment has changed this year will hear from us soon.
