Saul Sunday:

This year Bishop McGuckian will celebrate Mass at 3pm on Ist June. He encourages us all to be 'Pilgrims of Hope', joining him at Saul to reflect on Patrick's legacy and welcome the 'Sacred Heart Pilgrim Statue' to our Diocese - one of four pilgrim statues blessed by his holiness Pope Francis.

The Pilgrim Sacred Heart statue will move from Saul to St Patrick's, Downpatrick on Monday 2nd June.

On Tuesday 3rd June the statue will arrive in St McCartan's church, Loughinisland. There will be a Mass of the Sacred Heart at 7.30pm that evening.

On Wednesday 4th June, Mass will be at 10am and the children will share the story of the Scared Heart with us. There will also be times of prayer apart from the Mass times.
